

Sport Pedagogy: Non-Thesis Masters Requirements for Physical Education Teacher Education/Secondary Licensure Program

This program is for those individuals who wish to be eligible for receiving licensure to teach in the Utah public schools.

This is most pertinent for those who did not earn an undergraduate degree in exercise and sport science. **Graduate tuition waivers cannot be applied toward undergraduate courses.**
