

Clinical Instructor Position

POSITION: A Clinical Instructor position with the Department of Exercise and Sport Science. The position will be affiliated primarily with the PEAK Academy, the clinical entity within the Department.

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum of masters degree in exercise science with an emphasis in exercise physiology, 2-3 years of experience in a clinical exercise setting with skills in scheduling and conducting health, fitness, and physical performance assessments in both field and laboratory settings. The prospective candidate must be comfortable with managing a human performance testing laboratory, including the ordering of supplies and equipment; planning individualized fitness programs; as well as supervising both graduate and undergraduate students. Experience teaching applied exercise science courses is desirable.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Responsibilities will include: 1) coordinate and direct wellness/fitness testing for University and off-campus personnel/clients; 2) train student test administrators for the wellness/fitness testing; 3) maintain the equipment and supplies involved in the wellness/fitness testing; 4) schedule and supervise undergraduate and graduate students test administrators; 5) direct practicum experiences for graduate and undergraduate students; and 6) teach applied exercise science courses as needed by the program.

COMPENSATION: Rank and salary competitive and commensurate with qualifications of the applicant.
