- Position:** Instructor/Assistant/Associate Professor of Exercise and Sport Science (Non-Tenure Track [Lecturer]). Begin August 16, 2008.
- Qualifications:** The Department of Exercise and Sport Science has an established undergraduate Physical Education Teacher Education program and a Master's Program with secondary teaching licensure, and a doctoral program. We are seeking a faculty member interested in contributing to our pedagogy and related curricula and to be the Coordinator of the K-12 Undergraduate Teacher Certification program and Field Supervisor for student teachers. Applicants must have a master's degree (doctorate preferred) with an emphasis in physical education pedagogy and K-12 school teaching experience in physical education.
- Responsibilities:** The candidate will teach undergraduate physical education courses, coordinate the undergraduate teacher certification program, supervise field-based practicum experiences and student teachers, work with practicing teachers, and have the potential to serve on Masters and Doctoral student committees and teach graduate level courses. The candidate is expected to provide service to the program, department, college, university, and profession.
