ADDITIONAL PETE REQUIREMENTS

1. **Classes for Upper Division Requirement** (45 Semester Hours).
2. **Teaching Minor / Endorsement is STRONGLY recommended, but not required:**
biology, chemistry, communication, economics, English, geography, geology, health education, history, Languages (French, German, Latin, Russian, and Spanish), mathematics, physics, political science, psychology, reading and TESOL.
3. **Students must be accepted to the ESS PETE Licensure Program prior to taking ESS 4700, ESS 4710, ESS 5491 and ESS 5495.**
4. **Background Check for Initial Certification-** All applicants for teaching certificates in Utah are required to have a background check including fingerprinting. To access the Educator Background Check the educator will need to go to: www.utah.gov/teachers and select Background Check application.
5. **PRAXIS II** – Students must complete the PRAXIS II Physical Education Content Exams prior to being recommended for certification. These Exams may be taken at the beginning of the semester in which you student teach.
