

## To Calculate your PRT GPA

<b>PRT Class (example)</b>	<b>Credit Hours per class</b>	<b>Multiply by the numerical grade equivalent</b>	<b>Product of the multiplication</b>
PRT 3100	3	4.0 (A)	12
PRT 3780	3	3.3 (B+)	9.9
PRT 3440	4	2.3 (C+)	9.2
Totals	10		31.10
Divide	31.30 (product of multiplication) divided by 10 (total credit hours) equals your PRT GPA of 3.11
