

# NOTICE TOURISM STUDENTS

## SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP UTAH – KEITH GRIFFALL SCHOLARSHIP

This has been made possible through the support of the National Tourism Foundation and named in honor of Keith Griffall, a past president of the National Tour Association. This scholarship recognizes outstanding students pursuing an undergraduate degree in the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Tourism with a career interest in the tourism industry.

The application and required materials will be submitted to the Chair of the PRT Scholarship Committee, after which the committee will evaluate the recommendations and make a final selection. The recipient will be acknowledged at the PRT Department's Annual Awards Ceremony. The Chair of the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Tourism will administer the scholarship.

### *Criteria*

1. Applicant will submit: a PRT Department Scholarship Form, all associated document listed on that form, and a three page essay (details are listed below).
  - **Topic to include a discussion** of a current challenge or problem facing the tourism industry.
  - **Analysis** of relevant concepts and skills learned in PRT majors classes that apply to the resolution of the problem
2. Applicant must be an undergraduate student
3. Applicant must have at least two semesters completed as a PRT major, with a minimum of 15 PRT credits completed
4. GPA minimum is 3.0
5. Applicant must show experience in the travel related industry.
6. The applicant will be judged through:
  - Application
  - Official transcripts, overall GPA
  - Achievement in travel related courses
  - Personal statement of financial need
  - Quality of written essay.
